The Flower Festival



Welcome to the Capital of the Fens and to one of the finest flower festivals in England.

Set in the unique Fenland

landscape, the market town of Wisbech with its elegant Georgian architecture won an *Anglia in Bloom Gold award in both 2008 and 2009 and was judged best large town in Britain in Bloom last year.*

During Rose Fair the whole town takes on a festive atmosphere, celebrating its horticultural heritage. The jewel in the crown is the magnificent church of St Peter & St Paul where this year the theme for the breathtaking floral displays is 'Saturday Night at the Movies', bringing together traditional flowers and exotic blooms.

There are floral displays also in all the other town centre churches, each with its own particular theme and character so there are 4 flower festivals to visit in one go!

Rose Fair began in 1963 when locally grown rose buds were sold in the church gardens to raise funds for the restoration of this historic church which dates back to Norman times.

Rose growing is still a speciality of the area and the flower festival continues to raise money to maintain the fabric of the church.



St Peter & St Paul's Church

The church is open until 8pm most evenings during the festival. Entry is free but donations are appreciated.

Refreshments are available from the church hall and in the marquee.

The church is set in an acre of stunning gardens which won a Green Flag Award in 2008. From Wednesday to Saturday of Rose Fair the gardens host a wide variety of stalls selling local produce and plants, cakes and preserves, crafts and gifts, bric-a-brac and much more.

There is also entertainment in Museum Square, exhibitions in the museum, an art exhibition at Wisbech Castle and a display of historic vehicles in the car park.
